



Bulletin # 2 – AASCA Small School Soccer Tournament

The **AASCA Small Schools' Soccer Tournament (March 10 through 14)** is just six weeks away. We are deep into preparations with many details still to sort out.

Twenty teams (12 boys', 8 girls') is a large number and we are exploring options for fields. Two fields just will not accommodate if all teams are to play two games per day. Clearly we have some challenges, and we are sorting them out. We will use the two fields at ISP, and one or two other fields at a second site to be determined.

A few important points and requests for your followup:

1. Provide us with your **hotel information** – on the form attached. It is absolutely critical that you make your arrangements if you have not done so already. Hotels are expensive in Panama City, and there are availability challenges for that week in March. The Country Inn Suites (El Dorado and Amador), Plaza Paitilla Inn and the Continental are our strong recommendations. It is getting quite late to book, so I hope all teams have done so already. Please send the form ASAP.
2. Provide us – on the form attached – your **roster of players**. 16 players per team for AASCA Small School Soccer.
3. The cost of participation is **\$400 per team**. A school bringing both a boys' and girls' team pays \$800. I will send you information shortly about how to send a wire transfer to ISP.
4. The Icebreaker Activity is scheduled for Wednesday evening, March 10, here at ISP.
